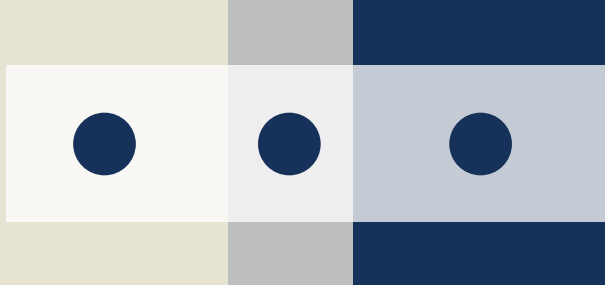

TOURNAMENT RULES

TEES:

Men play #2 tees/Ladies play #6 tees/Seniors 65 and over play #4.

USGA RULES:

The USGA Rules of Golf will govern all competition, as amended for local rules of play and those regarding the scramble format. UNLESS otherwise stated below.

SCRAMBLE FORMAT:

On every hole, each member of the team may hit a tee shot. The team then selects one of the tee shots from which to play. All members of the team may then hit from that position. The procedure is repeated until the ball is holed.

SELECTED SHOT:

Each team member may place his/her ball within two club lengths of the selected shot, but no nearer the hole. If the shot selected is played from a hazard, bunker, primary rough, secondary rough, fairway, or fringe of the green, the ball must be played from within two (2) club lengths of the shot selected, but no nearer the hole, and must remain in the hazard, bunker, primary rough, secondary rough, fairway, or fringe of the green.

IMPROVING LIE OF BALL- IN A HAZARD:

A team member may improve his/her lie by hand placing the ball.

IMPROVING LIE OF BALL - PUTTING GREEN:

When putting, the ball must be placed within one putter head length from the mark, but no nearer the hole. Once the ball is holed out, no further strokes count.

ONE PUTT RULE:

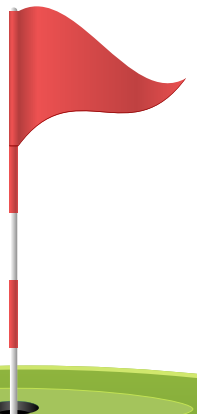
After the team gets a ball on the green that they choose to play, all members of the team will get one chance to make the putt, If the putt is made they record their score and move on the next hole.

If all team members miss the putt then they add 1 stroke to their score and record it as if they made the NEXT putt...

On a hole if the second shot lands on the green and all players miss the 1st putt then the score is recorded as a 4 and no one attempts the putt for the 4th shot, if a team makes their first putt the score is recorded as a 3. (No team member will make more than one putt per green.)

SPECIAL SKILL CONTESTS:

- Closest to Pin - Hole #4 and #14
- Closest to the Line - Hole #8
- Ring of Fire - Hole #12
- Longest Drive - Hole #13
